In particular terms Electrix is committed to:-

- Providing adequate resources and effort to prevent accidents and to strive to continually improve occupational health, safety and rehabilitation performance.
- Establishing measurable objectives and targets to ensure continued improvement aimed at eliminating work related injury and illness.
- Ensuring management at all levels are competent in health and safety management and regard health, safety and rehabilitation at the workplace as their highest priorities.
- Providing employees with adequate training, information and instruction on the hazards associated with their work and safe techniques for performing the job.
- Having every employee contribute to the important and responsible role of injury prevention.
- Providing safe plant and systems of work.
- Ensuring compliance with legislative requirements and industry standards.
- Ensuring workplace rehabilitation is commenced as soon as practicable, in accordance with medical advice.
- Ensuring as far as practicable that suitable duties are made available to injured workers to facilitate their safe and early return to work.
- Consultation with employees to ensure that Occupational Health Safety and Rehabilitation Plans, Policies and Procedures operate effectively.
